

Identify body found in Elkhorn River

OMAHA, Neb. (AP)—Authorities have identified the body of a man found in the Elkhorn River near here on May 9.

The Douglas County Sheriff's office said the man was Mark Carpenter, 22. When his body was found, an autopsy showed he had three wounds, apparently inflicted by a shotgun.

The FBI identified the body through latent fingerprints.

Carpenter was known to have worked in Omaha, the Sheriff's office said.

His parents live in Missouri, it was reported.
