

Seek slayer of watch repairman

OMAHA (AP). A middle aged woman who "saw someone" Friday night in the shop where Thomas Douglas, 55 year old Omaha watch repairman, was found slain was questioned Sunday by Omaha police, Inspector Fred Franks of the detective bureau said.

Franks also said detectives are seeking the identity of the person who called police, giving the name "Jones" and a false address, and advised them to investigate.

Douglas was found dead in the blood spattered back room of his shop. Franks said that altho there was no evidence of a struggle, four cuts from a sharp instrument were found in Douglas' skull. His pockets had been turned inside out.
