

## Fatal shooting gets man 30 years in prison

A Davenport man was sentenced to 30 years in prison last week for fatally shooting a man who was trying to prevent a fight outside an apartment.

Canares Ivy, 29, pleaded guilty last month of attempted murder and being a felon in possession of a handgun after initially being charged with first-degree murder.

He was among two people charged in the July 5 death of 24-year-old Tristan Menzl.

On Wednesday, Delbert Blake, 19, was sentenced to six years in prison for his role in Menzl's death.

Menzl was shot trying to prevent a fight between Blake and another man.

Ivy came from a nearby apartment to support Blake and shot Menzl.

Scott County District Court Judge Bobbi Alpers handed down the state-mandated 25-year sentence on attempted murder and gave Ivy the maximum five-year sentence for the weapons charge.
