

\$25,000 bond set in Omaha death

Omaha (UPI) — Bond was set at \$25,000 Monday for Larry B. Jackson, 28, of Omaha, accused of second-degree murder in the shooting Saturday of Pamela J. Chapman, 23, of Omaha.

The shooting occurred in the apartment Jackson and Miss Chapman shared, the Douglas County attorney's office said.

Miss Chapman was struck by a blast from a 12-gauge shotgun and was dead on arrival at an Omaha hospital, police said.

A preliminary hearing for Jackson was scheduled May 11 in Omaha Municipal Court.

The bond included a 10% provision, meaning Jackson could be released after posting \$2,500. Late Monday, Jackson was still being held.
