

Omaha man sentenced in shooting

Omaha (AP) — Howard Kelly, 21, of Omaha, has been sentenced to 10 years in prison for the fatal shooting of Fred Marshall Jr. last July 11.

Kelly pleaded guilty on Oct. 18 to a reduced charge of manslaughter on Oct. 18.

His brother, Eligah Kelly, 27, pleaded guilty on Oct. 18 to being an accessory to the shooting after the fact, a misdemeanor. He was sentenced to one day in jail.

Witnesses said Marshall and Howard Kelly confronted each other in front of an Omaha hotel before the shooting.
