

Sioux City police arrest man after fatal shooting

Sioux City, Ia. — A Sioux City man was arrested Friday in an early-morning shooting death here, police said.

Cedric B. Theus, 20, was charged with first-degree murder in the death of Terrance Gibson, 19, of Sioux City.

Police received a report of a man chasing another man with a gun about 3:15 a.m. in a residential area. They later found the dead man near there.

Theus was arrested about 5:30 a.m. without incident, police said.
