

FBI SEARCHES FOR SUSPECT

The FBI has entered the search for Clyde Milford Johnson, 35, of Des Moines, who is accused in the slaying of a 28-year-old Ames man here on July 24.

David Joseph Schmidt was shot in the back with a shotgun and was stabbed twice in the chest. Police believe the

slaying occurred in an apartment at 1334 Thirteenth st., occupied by Jerry Dudley Lee, 25.

Schmidt's body was found in a garage beside the apartment house where Lee lives. Police said Schmidt and some friends apparently went to Lee's apartment for a party after meeting Lee and some companions at an eastside tavern.

The FBI entered the case

after local officials asked that a federal fugitive warrant be issued on the basis that Johnson has fled the state in an effort to avoid prosecution for murder.

FBI agents said Johnson formerly lived at Kansas City, Mo., and that FBI agents have been searching for him there, in Des Moines and at other points.

Johnson was born at Holden, Mo. He has been known to use the aliases Clyde Milton Johnson, Larry Richard Johnson and Raymond Hardin. He is 5-feet, 10-inches tall, weighs about 160 pounds, has black hair and brown eyes.

2 Students Shot In Brazil Clash
